Notes

Catholic Belief:

- The Bread and Cup Transform into Jesus' literal body and blood once the Priest consecrates them in the Mass
- The Eucharist is a propitiatory sacrifice perpetuating the sacrifice of Jesus on the cross

What we believe:

- The Bread and Cup are spiritual symbols representing Jesus' body and blood. He is spiritually present at the supper, but not in the elements
- The Communion is a thanksgiving meal, and his propitiatory sacrifice was on the cross, not repeated during the meal
